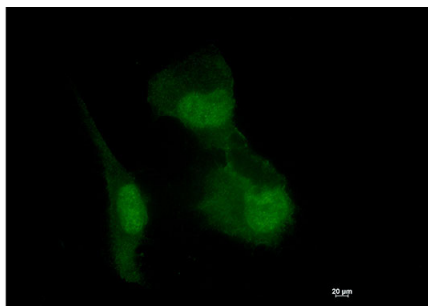

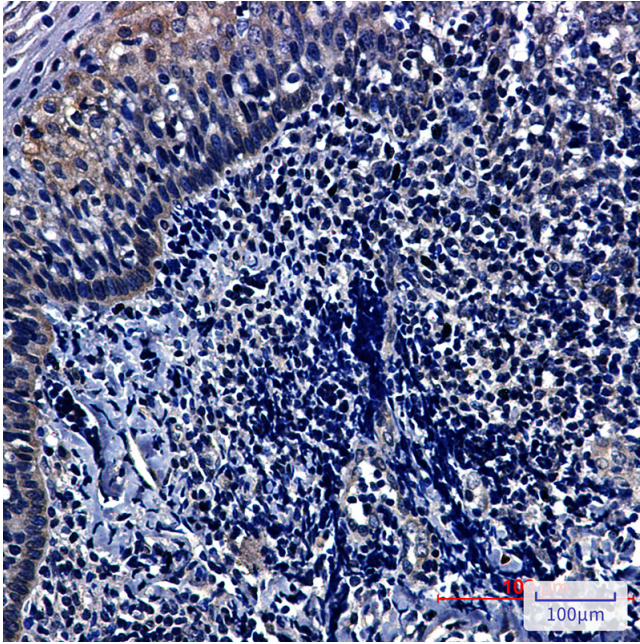

About Gene Symbol	HIF1AN (Hypoxia Inducible Factor 1 Subunit Alpha Inhibitor) is a metabolic enzyme involved in cellular metabolism. It is an important research target in metabolic disease, cancer metabolism, and drug discovery and is widely studied to elucidate cellular mechanisms and identify therapeutic targets.
