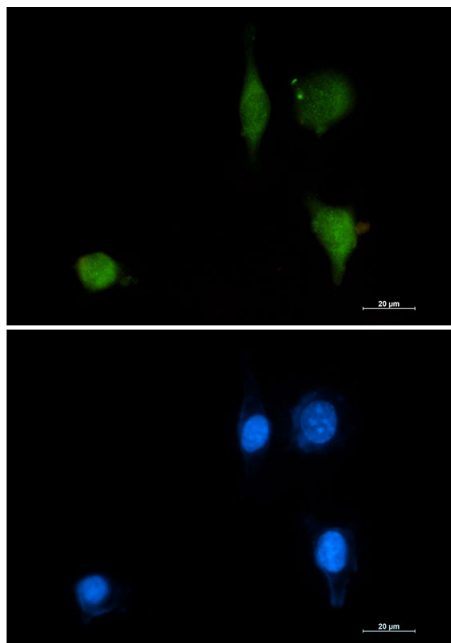

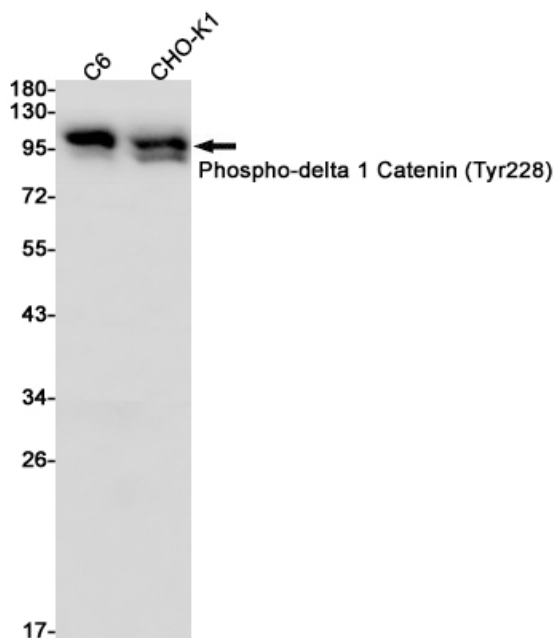

About Gene Symbol	CTNND1 (Catenin Delta 1) is a cell junction/adhesion protein involved in cytoskeletal organization. It is an important research target in cell biology, cancer metastasis, and cytoskeletal research and is widely studied to elucidate cellular mechanisms and identify therapeutic targets.
